

ACE INTERNATIONAL LETTER/PERCENT GRADING SYSTEM

The ACE International Letter/Percent Grading System is used to grade the Paces. Note the difference between the DL Letter/Percent Grading System. For example, 84% would be a grade of C with the paces, but a B+ with the DL system. The DL system is used for all additional activities and projects.

 74 - 79 D
 73 or lower F

Grade Point Average (GPA)

Each "A" = 3 points
 Each "B" = 2 points
 Each "C" = 1 point

Add the total points for all completed courses and divide by the total number of courses. This yields the student's grade point average.

Example:

Subject	Grade	Grade Points
1.Math	B-	2
2.Social Studies	C+	1
3. English	B+	2
4. Science	C	1
5. Literature	A-	3
Total points		9
Total subjects		5

$9 \div 5 = 1.8$ GPA is 1.8 on a 3point scale.

A 4 point scale includes the "D" grades which ACE Students don't use.
